# 1. Introduction

Welcome to your trial of RT Software's Tactic telestration software. This document will show you how to download, install and license Tactic.

Once you have done this we have a great video to help get you started using Tactic. We really recommend you watch this so you can learn the basics quickly.

Your trial will use a software code, so there's no need for USB dongles to be sent out.

## 2. Pre-Requisites

### 2.1. Suitable Hardware and PC Environment

Step 1. Before we get into setting up the software it is important to check that you have a suitable PC. You can check the hardware requirements on our website. Depending on whether you plan to use HD or UHD, the PC build may be different.

To run successfully you will need to use a PC with the recommended processor, memory, GPU and (optional) video card.

The Windows and PC environment should conform to the following:

- The user account name MUST have Administrator permissions.
- The software is installed for a single user and this cannot be changed without re-installing.
- The screen resolution must be 1920 x 1080 (or 1920 x 1200)
  
- SDI is an option and requires an AJA video card for SDI. We recommend you get started using imported and exported files and move onto SDI afterwards.

## **2.2. GPU (NVIDIA card)**

Some of the advanced features of Tactic, such as AI features, depend on the latest NVIDIA card driver.

It is important to upgrade your PC with the latest driver for your card before you start the Tactic software installation.

If you are unsure about whether your card is supported, use the Recommended Hardware link above, or speak to us.

## **2.3. Contact Us - Request the Licence**

You will probably have already filled out the form on our website, but if not, please go ahead and do that now by clicking on this link.

We will send you the licence code that you will need to run Tactic. The form will also allow us to better support you in your trial. The licence file will need to be saved to your PC once you receive it.

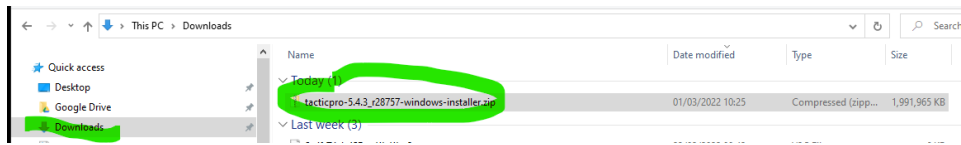

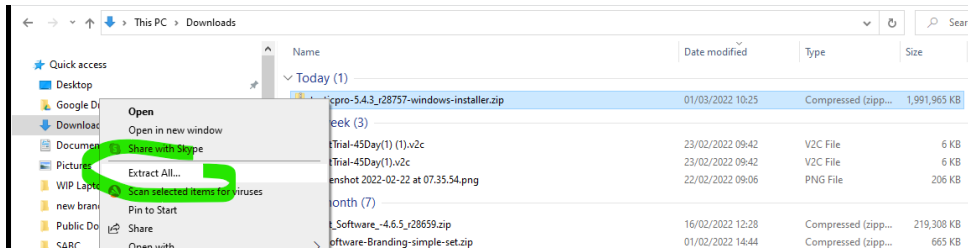
Click on the product you want and it will start downloading.

Once it has finished go to your PC's Download's folder. You will find your software downloaded as a .zip file as shown below.

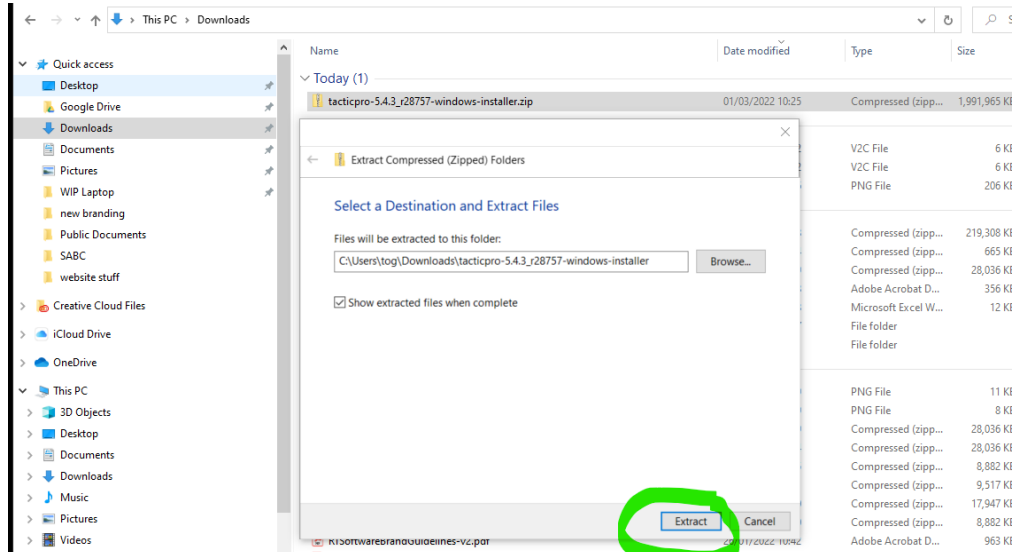
Before starting the installation make sure you have read the note on the GPU driver version above.



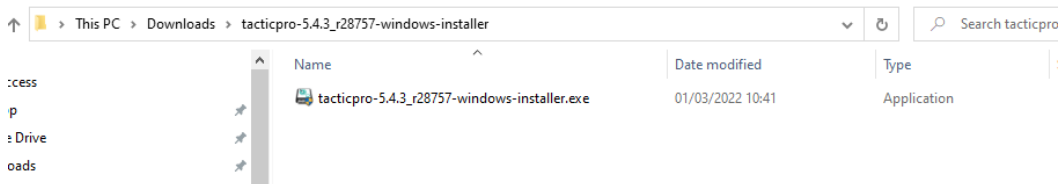
Right click this downloaded zip file and select Extract All...



Accept the default location and select Extract.



When the zipped file has finished being extracted to a folder, open it and you will find the installer.



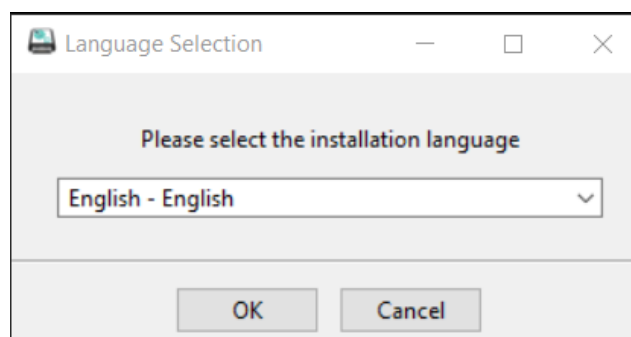
## 3. Setting Up

### 3.1. Installation

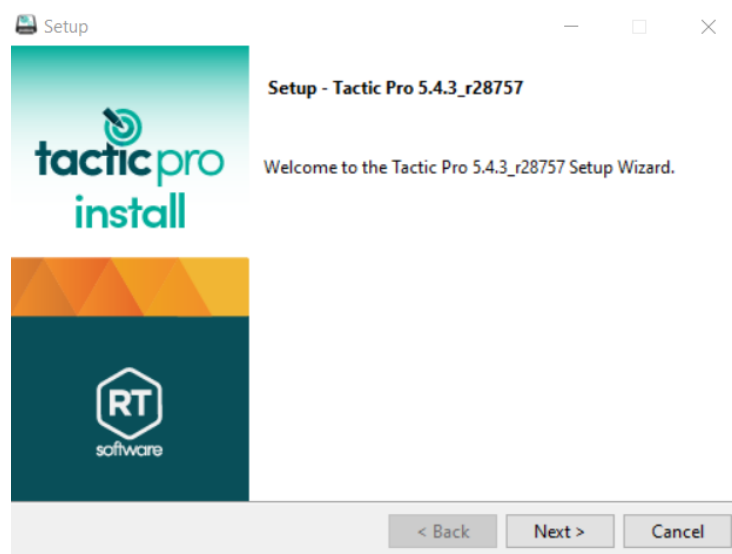
Run the installer by double clicking. (The name will vary from that shown in the screenshot as the release version numbers increase over time).

You may need to 'override', 'ignore' or select 'Run Anyway' any warnings from your anti-virus about the software being unknown before you can go ahead with the installation.

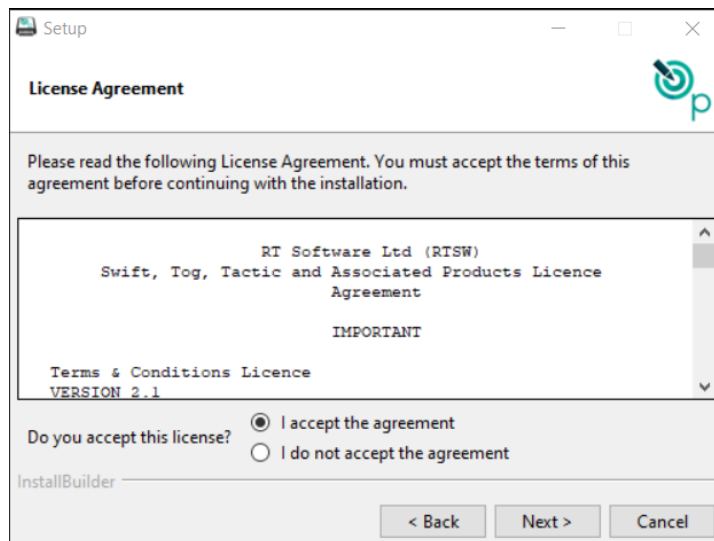
Then you will go through the Setup Wizard as below. Please choose your preferred language.



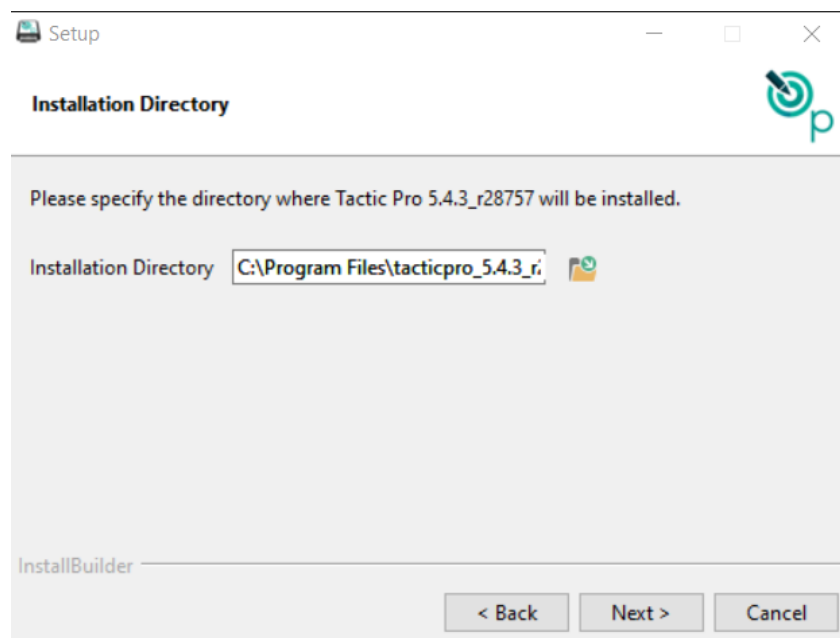
Then Next...



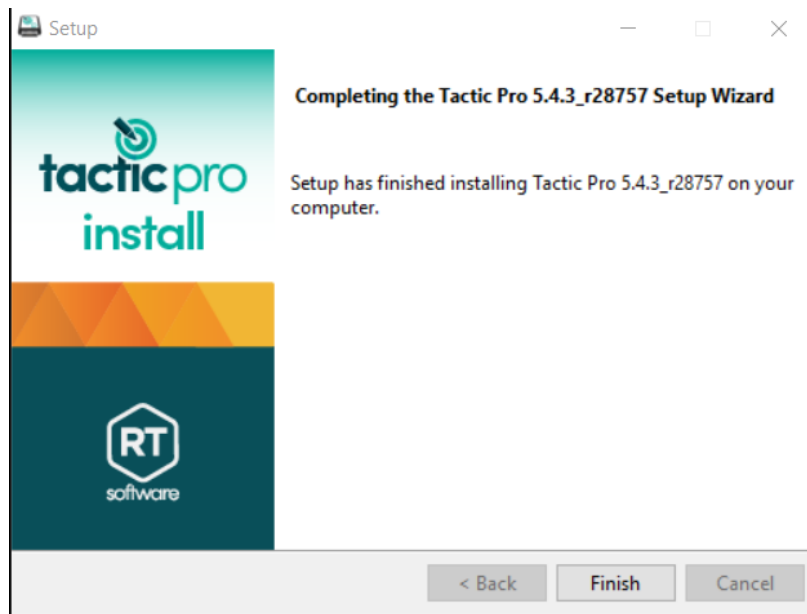
Tick the Accept Agreement option, then click Next.



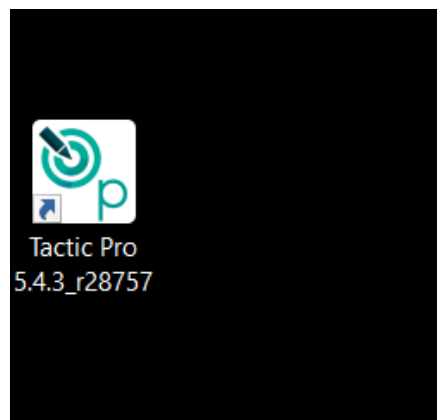
Then accept the default installation directory and Tactic will start installing.



The screen you will see when the installation completes.



When completed, you will find a new desktop icon to launch the version of Tactic you selected.



### 3.2. Optional Video I/O Installation

If you plan to use a video card in your trial, and you've checked you have a suitable card you can now run the AJA Driver.exe. You'll find this uploaded to our Tactic Trials page on the website.

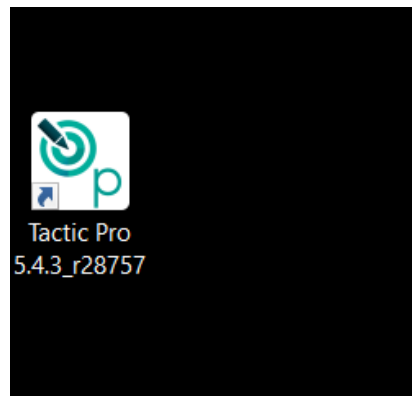

Note: We recommend starting using files only and move on to SDI afterwards. It is fine to skip the AJA install and come back to it later.

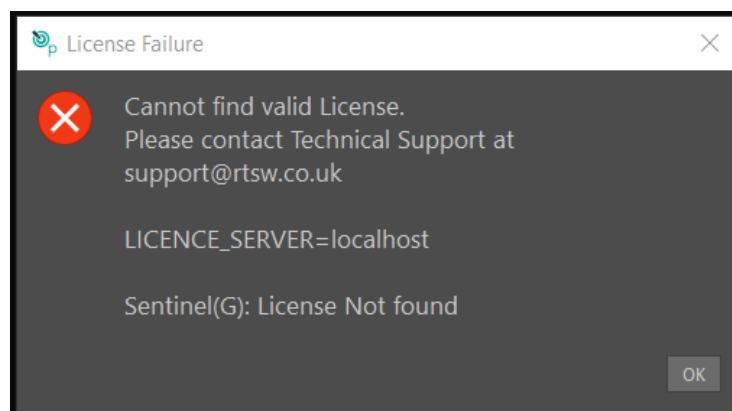
### 3.3. Installing the Licence

Launch Tactic using the new desktop shortcut. You should expect that this will fail until we have installed a licence.

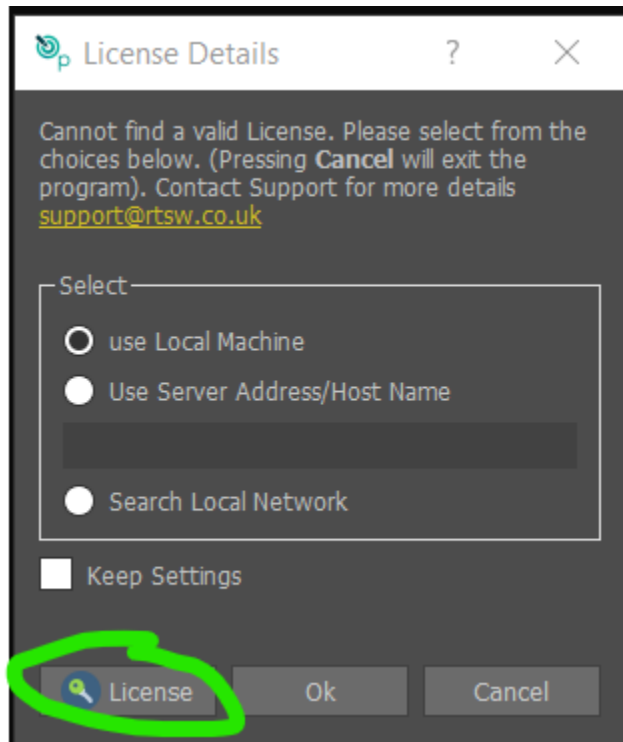

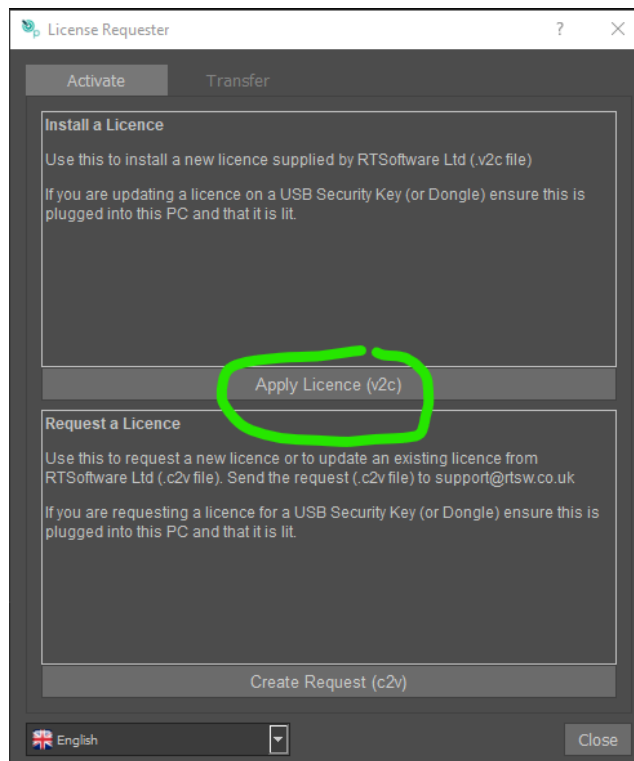
If Tactic is not yet licenced you will get this warning which you should click ok on.



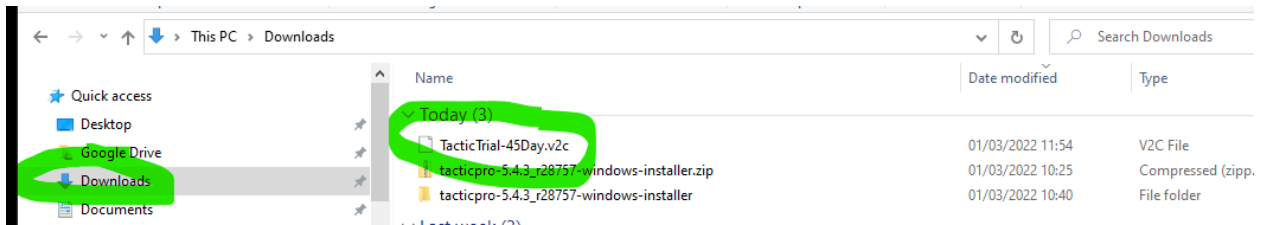
On the following screen, click Licence.



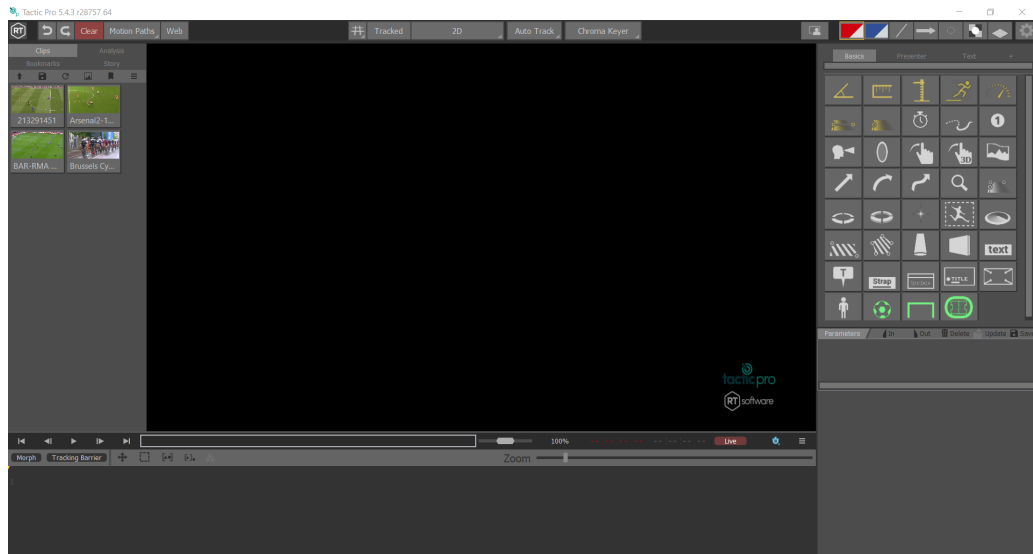
From the following screen select Apply Licence.



Then navigate to the TacticTrial.v2c file we sent to you and select it.



Tactic will now finish loading and will show you the interface ready to start your trial.
